### Virtues, Explained! Obedience

Disobedience was humanity's original sin. Conversely, obedience became the instrument of humanity's reconciliation to God.

Scripture calls man's submission of his own intellect and will to God, the author of revelation, "the obedience of faith." (CCC 143) "To obey in faith is to submit freely to the word that has been heard, because its truth is guaranteed by God, who is Truth itself," we read in the Catechism (CCC 144).

We see perfect obedience shown by Christ amidst his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. His human will dreads what will come — "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me" — but his divine will, which is never at odds with his human will, submits to the Truth: "Yet, not as I will, but as you will." (Matthew 26:39). Despite his fear, he embraces the divine will for man to be redeemed, and so we say that he was "obedient unto death." (Philippians 2:8)

## Reflexion del Evangelio...Gospel Reflection

**31 de mayo de 2026**  
**La Santísima Trinidad**

¡Gloria al Padre, gloria al Hijo y gloria al Espíritu Santo! “¡Así amó Dios al mundo! Le dio al Hijo Único, para que quien cree en él no se pierda, sino que tenga vida eterna” (Juan 3:16). Después de la solemnidad de Pentecostés, que celebramos el domingo pasado, la Iglesia nos invita ahora a celebrar el gran misterio de la Santísima Trinidad: misterio de amor y de unidad.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (número 253) nos habla del dogma de la Santísima Trinidad:

La Trinidad es una. No confesamos tres dioses sino un solo Dios en tres personas: "la Trinidad consubstancial". Las personas divinas no se reparten la única divinidad, sino que cada una de ellas es enteramente Dios: "El Padre es lo mismo que es el Hijo, el Hijo lo mismo que es el Padre, el Padre y el Hijo lo mismo que el Espíritu Santo, es decir, un solo Dios por naturaleza". "Cada una de las tres personas es esta realidad, es decir, la substancia, la esencia o la naturaleza divina". Por la gracia del bautismo, "en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo", somos llamados a participar en la vida de la Bienaventurada Trinidad: aquí abajo, en la oscuridad de la fe, y después de la muerte, en la luz eterna (CIC 265). Dios es amor, y cualquiera de nosotros que haya experimentado lo que es el verdadero amor puede comprender, por la gracia del Espíritu Santo, este gran misterio de fe. La esencia de la Trinidad es servir y amar; por lo tanto, como cristianos, a eso estamos llamados: a servir y amar.

**May 31, 2026**  
**The Most Holy Trinity**

I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God's love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today's Gospel reveals: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly.

## St. Norbert | June 6

Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten (c. 1075-1134), was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany. However, at court, it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power, and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God, while traveling in a storm, he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert, and he became penitent, left his court post, and, after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes, but at the Pope's request, finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine Order, established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded a women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany, where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament; this earned him the title "Apostle of the Blessed Sacrament." He and those of his orders had a great love of and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, with a devout faith in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Eventually, he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II against the antipope. Afterward, he returned to Germany to the court of Emperor Lothar as an advisor. At end of his life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg, where he died. St. Norbert of Xanten, pray for us.

## San Norberto | 6 de junio

Nacido en la nobleza, San Norberto de Xanten (c. 1075-1134) fue ordenado subdiácono y sirvió en la corte de Enrique V, emperador de Alemania. Sin embargo, en la corte era fácil distraerse con la riqueza, el poder y el lujo, y allí vivió una vida mundana y corrupta. Por la gracia de Dios, mientras viajaba en una tormenta, casi fue alcanzado por un rayo y casi muere. Esta experiencia cambió a San Norberto, que se arrepintió, dejó su cargo en la corte y, tras un periodo de discernimiento en un monasterio, sintió la llamada a ser sacerdote.

Norberto se convirtió en predicador itinerante, predicando contra las actitudes mundanas, pero a petición del Papa, finalmente se estableció en el norte de Francia y fundó la Orden Norbertina, establecida según la regla de San Agustín. La orden creció rápidamente y pronto fundó una rama femenina. Norbert viajó y predicó por toda Alemania, donde también fundó una rama laica de los norbertinos. En Bélgica predicó contra las herejías que negaban el Santísimo Sacramento; esto le valió el título de "Apóstol del Santísimo Sacramento." Él y los miembros de sus órdenes tenían un gran amor y devoción por el Santísimo Sacramento, con una fe devota en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa.

Finalmente, fue nombrado arzobispo de Magdeburgo, Alemania, y más tarde viajó a Roma en apoyo del papa Inocencio II contra el antipapa. Posteriormente, regresó a Alemania para la corte del emperador Lotario como consejero. Al final de su vida, con la salud deteriorada, San Norberto fue llevado de vuelta a Magdeburgo, donde murió. San Norberto de Xanten, ruega por nosotros.

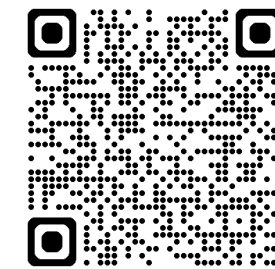
